We waited a short time, but their horses needed to settle so they said to go ahead, they would take their time. There are two offices in Oklahoma, Tulsa and Oklahoma City. Money raised was split between the two locations.

Each office was sent \$2600.

Virginia, Barn Party sent to the Richmond, VA Office \$70

There were \$185.00 worth of checks made out to the American Cancer Society and these were sent there.




